Interest: I want to foster a strong community and neighborhood feeling at Exeter.

**Qualifications:** I love the community and have advocated for folks on various topics including growth / development of communities. I also work as a finance manager and can provide expert P&L analysis and advisory.

Qualifications: I have served the Exeter community and homeowners in the roles of Treasurer of the Exeter Homeowners Association for over 20 years, as a former President of the Association, and as a contributing member of multiple committees during that time. My objective has been to ensure Exeter has the necessary funding for operations and capital improvements while keeping Exeter assessments low, and value to residents high. As a direct result of my cost management efforts, Exeter was able to fund the over \$1M pond and dam improvement project required by the Virginia DCR, and yet keep assessments as low as possible. Exeter assessments for both single family and townhome residents continue to be at least 14% less than for comparable HOAs in Leesburg, and unlike most of those HOAs, Exeter did not raise assessments for 2024.
